AWAY TOURNAMENT

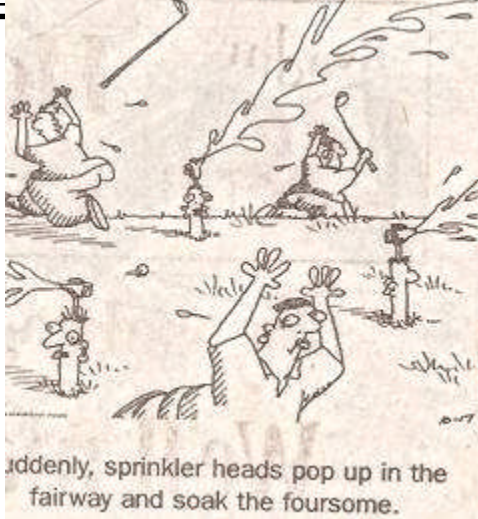

TOURNAMENT NEWS JIM GONZALES

On April 5th and April 6th, the Annual Recreation Park Invitational was played. The weather was great, as was the condition of the course. The tournament was very competitive, and there were some great scores. We experimented with a new format for the Invitational and from all the feedback it appears it was a huge success. We will continue with the Partner's Best Ball for both days, and the ECLECTIC format for the overall for next year's Invitational.

We had two holes-in-one during the Invitational. Jim Kidder had a hole-in-one on Saturday on Hole #5. Unfortunately, Jim was not in the hole-in-one pot. However, he bought a round of drinks for everyone anyway. Congratulations, Jim, and thanks for the beer. On Sunday, Lou Soto's guest, Scott Baldwin, had a hole-in-one on Hole #12. Two hole in ones in the tournament and the hole-in-one pot is still alive.

Ryan Harlow and his staff at Recreation Park had the course in superb condition, and the greens were fast and firm. A big thanks to Ryan and their entire crew for helping to make the Invitational a huge success. The pin placements were excellent. I also want to thank the Tournament Committee and the members and officers of the club who helped on the starting and scoring tables. The volunteers who help at the tournament are invaluable. There's no way we could run these large events without them.

A special thanks to Bruce Gattton for doing all the computer work, and to Earl Gillings. Earl did not play in the tournament so that he could take all the pictures of the teams on Saturday. He also developed the pictures and had them ready for distribution on Sunday. And Gordon, thanks for arranging for the tee prizes.

The pace of play for both days was great! So, it seems to me, if we can play in a reasonable time with guests that aren't familiar with the golf course on hard and fast greens, we should certainly be able to play at that pace when we play our regular tournaments with members only. Something to think about.

On Wednesday, April 23rd the RPMGC will host the PLGA Association Day Golf Tournament and business meeting. Representatives from PLGA member clubs along with the PLGA Executive Committee will play golf starting at 8 am. We already have a number of Rec Park members signed up to play in the tournament. Entry fee is \$31 per player for Recreation Park club members with the usual optional side pots. We host this event annually and always have a lot of

participation from our Men's Club. Entries will close for this event on Friday, April 14th. After golf on the 23rd, the RPMGC will host a dinner for the PLGA. All club members are welcome - dinner is \$24. There will be an interesting program after dinner on all the technical equipment (launch and MOI monitors) used in golf club fitting with live demonstrations, put on by Richard Leach. Richard is a Master club fitter from Woodley GC. You're all invited.

Our next club tournament will be a Four-some 1-2-3 Tournament on Saturday, May 3rd. One, two or three balls will count from the foursome depending on the hole. Entry fee for the tournament is \$35 per player and, of course, we will have the usual sidepots. The tournaments fill up fast and there are already a significant number of entries for May. Remember, requests for tee times are taken by receipt date of the entry. Get your entry in early and don't be disappointed. You can sign up as a foursome or a single or anything in between.

The next day, Sunday, May 4th will be our AWAY Tournament at the new Links of Summerly in Lake Elsinore. The deadline for entry is Friday, April 25th at 5 pm. It appears that we will be able to get enough players to have an 8 am shotgun.

The price for this event is \$70 per player. That covers green fees, carts, range balls and prize fund. We will never get this price again. Please let me know as soon as possible if you are planning on playing. You will find an application for this tournament in this newsletter. Guests from outside the men's club are welcome.

Following that will be an Individual Stroke Play event on Sunday, June 22nd. The next week, there will be a NASSAU on Sunday, June 29th. Entry fee for both of these tournaments is \$35 per player. We have a long break between tournaments due to the Long Beach Golf Festival. Also, there will be an ECLECTIC combination tournament using the tournament rounds of June 22nd and June 29th. If you want to enter this combined 36-hole event, the entry is an additional \$8. You must pay the \$8 entry fee before you tee off in the June 22nd tournament to be eligible. In the ECLECTIC format, you take the best score on each hole for the two rounds and that becomes your score for the ECLECTIC (best 18 holes). The combination ECLECTIC has been a lot of fun with some surprising results.

Just a reminder. If you cancel out of a tournament less than 9 days prior to the tournament, you will lose your entry fee - NO exceptions. We have to commit to the golf course by that date. That is CLUB POLICY, and we will continue to enforce that policy.

Also the local rules for our club have been updated to include all the young staked trees that
