## TOURNAMENT NEWS JIM GONZALES

Our 2009 Tournament Year came to a close with the Chicken and Bean Tournament on Sunday, December 6th. The Chicken Lovers team had a decisive victory over the Bean Haters team by a score of 97 to 59. The tournament committee appreciates all the positive comments that have been received on the tournament and the year in general. We look forward to 2010. We will continue to improve every facet of the tournaments for you.

The tournament committee will aggressively be attacking the slow pace of play in our tournaments in 2010. The goal is for all the groups to finish in 4 1/2 hours or less. This process will begin in January 2010 by monitoring the pace of play at several places on the golf course. The groups that can't maintain a 4 1/2 hour pace will be placed at the back of the fields in future tournaments. So, for those of you who wish to play early, you need to police your own group and make sure you maintain the pace of play. The RPMGC Pace of Play Policy is posted at the club, on the website, and is available at the Starting Table at all tournaments.

The first tournament for 2010 will be our Membership Tournament on Saturday, January 2nd. This will be an Individual Stroke Play Tournament in four flights with all the usual side pot action. Entry fee is \$41 per player. Please remember, the first three tournaments of the year are limited fields due to daylight restrictions. There are always waiting lists for tournaments at the beginning of the year. If you want to play, send your PAID entry in as soon as possible so you won't be disappointed.

The Sunday, February 7th tournament is the very popular Foursome 6-6-3-3 event. The entry fee is \$41 per player. This one will fill up quickly. You can sign up as a foursome or a single or anything in between. The complete 2010 Tournament Schedule is available at the club, on the website and in the newsletter.

I want to take this opportunity to thank all the volunteers who work on the tournament committee. There are far too many members who are involved to mention in this limited space. 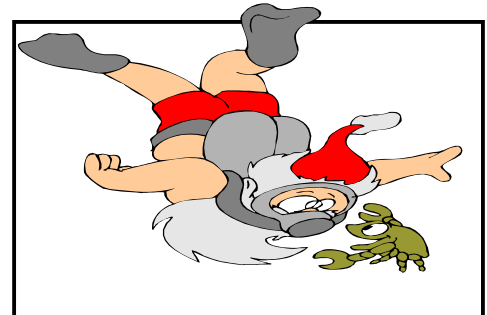
