Frank previously was our PLGA rep. and currently Member at Large on our Board of Directors. Jim Gonzales was also elected to chair Course ratings for the PLGA.

### QUAD TOURNAMENT

I just got word that the Quad tournament will be held April 26th from 7 a.m. till noon at Lakewood Country Club. I do not have the cost at this time, will post on website and bulletin board as soon as it becomes available. We won this event last year. The Quad tournament is made up of 40 players each from Rec Park, Skylinks, El Dorado and Lakewood. A player from each course makes up the foursome. Scoring from each group as follows: 3 points for low net, 2 points for second low net and 1 point for third low net, ties split the points. The scores are accumulated and the course with the most points win the trophy for the year.

## TOURNAMENT NEWS JIM GONZALES

The first two tournaments of the year are in the books. Both January and February had full fields. Thanks to all the new and old volunteers who make the tournaments so successful. The club appreciates your work.

The next tournament will be a Modified Stableford format event on Sunday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>. The entry fee is \$35 per player. The scoring in a Stableford competition is by points awarded in relation to a fixed score for each hole.

The Annual 2-Day Invitational will follow on Saturday and Sunday, April 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. The entry fee is \$94 per player, \$188 per team. No entries will be accepted without the full \$188 entry fee. The format for the Invitational is a Partners Best Ball on Saturday and a Partners Aggregate on Sunday. You may bring a Guest as a partner or you may partner with another member of the club. Your partner can be male or female.

The Invitational fills up faster than any of our tournaments. It's one of the best of the year with lots of prizes and side pot money. This event always sells out quickly and we always have a full field. Get your partner lined up and get your paid entry in as soon as possible so you won't be disappointed.

Also in April, the Rec Park Mens Club will be hosting PLGA Association Day on Wednesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>. Representatives from PLGA member clubs along with the Executive Committee of the PLGA will play golf starting at 8 am. I'd like to encourage the members of our club to come out and play in the tournament. The entry fee is \$31. We always have a lot of Rec Park members participate, and I anticipate another good turnout from the Mens Club. You can sign up with other members of Rec Park or play as a single, whatever. Just let me know.

After the association day tournament, there will be a dinner and the monthly PLGA meeting. Dinner is an additional \$23 and you are all welcome to attend.

The foursome events have become quite popular in the club. It gives us a chance to have some team competition while still being able to have all the usual individual side pots. In May, we will hold another team event - format to be announced.

### CART RENTAL

There have been people riding the golf carts without paying. If you do not pay you do not ride. We are very fortunate to be able to rent a half cart, so as to be sure we keep this privilege anyone caught riding a cart that hasn't paid will be disqualified from the tournament. We will strictly enforce this rule.

**HANDICAP CHAIRMANS' REPORT BY DICK KINER ON PAGE 4**

**ANNUAL NOTICE 31**

Your USGA Handicap Index is widely recognized in America and elsewhere as a reliable measure of your potential ability. Your Handicap Index is used for conversion to a Course Handicap, which indicates the number of strokes a player receives from a specific set of tees.

Your Rec Park Handicap Committee administers a record keeping procedures on tournament play to assure the correct adjusted score has been posted. The effort is to assure that the club makes the game of golf enjoyable for all of its members and that tournament play is conducted in fair and equitable competition. In 2007 we have faithfully applied the system at your club. Every score posted or not has been corrected if needed to provide a perfect record (See the 2007 club Record on the Bulletin Board at Rec Park.

How well our membership continue to comply with the USGA Handicap System depends, in large part, on how well their responsibilities in The System are understood.

The biggest problem at Rec Park is with posting the correct adjusted score and the lack of understanding the Equitable Stroke Control. USGA introduced a simple, straight forward, and easy-to-remember procedure to adjust scores under Equitable Stroke Control that sets a Maximum number strokes that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's Course Handicap. Memorize this chart it is posted At the computer at Rec Park.

Course Handicap	Maximum Number Posted on Any Hole
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 or more	10

**In 2008 ACTION WILL BE TAKEN IN CASE OF FAILURE TO POST A TOURNAMENT SCORE AT REC PARK.**

A USGA Handicap Index shall be adjusted up or down if the player does not turn in all acceptable scores or otherwise does not observe the spirit of the USGA Handicap System. The Handicap Committee determines the amount of adjustment.

It is equitable to enter the score and/or a penalty score when a player fails to post a score. A penalty score is a score with the corresponding Ratings equal to the lowest handicap differential in the player's scoring record used to compute his or her last USGA Handicap Index. If the Omitted score is unusually high a penalty score should equal the highest differential in the player's scoring record. In case of a player's Repeated failure to comply with the USGA Handicap System, the Committee may withdraw the player's Handicap Index. Also, the Handicap Committee will examine the results of competitions and take appropriate action if net scores appear out of line.

**ANNUAL NOTICE #2**

Scores are to be posted and returned to the Tournament scoring table and posted to the computer at the clubhouse.

Handicap cards are mailed and when handicaps are revised, our labels are kept in a box at the computer in the clubhouse. All Tournaments at Rec Park are going to be designated tournament scores.

How to adjust a gross score for handicap purposes and to know if an adjusted score is acceptable for posting and how to post an adjusted score for all acceptable rounds including tournament rounds were covered in Annual Notice #1.

How to post an away score: This can be done on the Internet if you have the course rating and slope for the course you played use the PLGA Website and register your score under your Handicap #, or posting it at the away sheet at the computer at Re Park

**Display Table, Rating, and Handicap Lists**

Course Handicap Tables are at the computer in the clubhouse. You need to consult the Course Handicap Table in order to convert your Handicap Index to a Course Handicap for the tees being played. The Tables which are based on USGA Slope Ratings, are issued to Re Park by PLGA our authorized golf association. The Tables are posted at the computer and bulletin board in the clubhouse.

The USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating from every set of tee markers are printed on our club's scorecard and posted on the bulletin board at the club. You need to know these Ratings in order to post a score. The Ratings, the date of play, your name or PLGA # and the adjusted score (including the correct score type designation) constitute a complete score entry for handicap purposes. The Ratings should also be easily retrievable on the screen of a computer used for score posting.

## GOLF COMMISSIONER REPORT- HAL PEABODY

After having the month of December off from the Golf Commission meetings, January got off to a bang. First, there is a new on line tee time reservation system that American Golf implemented. It seems their announcement was almost word of mouth, although they said it was announced in the newspaper and there were demonstrations at the course. The system was implemented on January 21<sup>st</sup> amid much confusion. It seems the system wasn't quite ready for prime time on the first day. Also, American Golf confused every one by giving out the Sunday times on Monday instead of Tuesday. It turns out the rain probably washed the day out anyway. With the on-line tee time system, tee times can be reserved eight days in advance and eventually the phone system will become obsolete. The Golf Commission is also reviewing the over-all weekend and shotgun Tournament Policy for the Long Beach Courses. It seems as if there are more and more weekend tournaments being scheduled that are taking starting times away from the public. As Chairman of the Tournaments committee, I edited the old policy and the recommended changes will be discussed before the February Golf Commission meeting. As far as Rec Park goes, the bunkers are to be roto-tilled to soften them up; but what they really need is more sand! In 2007 Rec Park was number two in American Golf's Southern California properties in rounds played behind La Mirada. In Long Beach Rec Park had 118,252, El Dorado 99,297 and the premier golfing destination in Long Beach, Sky-links, had 78,073 rounds played. Overall the rounds were up 1.95% in Long Beach in 2007 over 2006. Rec Park was up 4.3% over the previous year.
