TOURNAMENT NEWS JIM GONZALES

An increase of \$1.00 to \$37.00 for our regular tournaments, effective 6-20-09 to cover the City surcharge. Thanks to everyone who played in the June 28th Individual Stroke Play for their cooperation in collecting the additional \$1. As for the past incorrect entry fee fiasco there will be a spreadsheet available on the website in about a week so that you can identify whether or not you have any credits coming. You can then use those credits for upcoming tournaments. Remember, however, you cannot mix credits between the regular and senior tournaments. All these credits amount to is a few dollars per player, but as you can imagine, it is a bookkeeping nightmare. Thanks for your understanding and ongoing help in getting this credit situation resolved. If you take a credit, be sure to note that fact on your entry form. \$37 will be the basic entry fee for the REGULAR tournaments for the foreseeable future.

The weather for the June 28th tournament was great, only to be surpassed by the condition of the golf course. When you see Ryan Harlow or Jesse Sanford, please let them know what a great job they are doing, not only with the superb condition of the golf course and the greens, but also the many things they do for the men's club. We are very lucky to be able to work with these two fine professionals. The pace of play for the June 28th tournament was basically better, with the exception of the times from 9:30 or so until the end of the tournament. The playing time went from 4 hours 20 minutes to 5 hours and 15 minutes during this period of time. We lost almost an hour of elapsed time during the last hour and a half of our tee times. We will continue to address the pace of play problem. The results of the June 28th tournament and the 36-hole Eclectic are contained in this newsletter.

There are no regular tournaments in the month of July due to the Long Beach Golf Festival. We will get back to tournament action on Saturday, August 8th with the 24-33-45 Foursome Event. Bob Caseres, TJ Hyman, Ron Johns and Dom Juneau should be back to defend their title that they won with a 157 team score last year. Here is the format for this team event. The team will take the two (2) low net balls on and all four (4) net balls on the five-pars. Par for the event is 168. You can sign-up as a foursome - or a single, or anything all the four-pars, the three (3) low net balls on all the three-pars, in between. Entry fee

TIMING ON 18

For the last 4 months we have timed players on the 18th hole and the way it works is we have the group ahead (onel player) wait until the group behind finishes and marks down the time from the clock at the 18th hole. We have had several groups ignore this rule, in the future if you do not wait your group will be DQ'd from the tournament.

SCRIPT & SIDEPOT MONEY

Again we have had problems with sidepot money & script, script & sidepot money is given to you at the tournament. Both regular and senior monies are handed out. If you play in both senior & regular you will receive your script in the next tournament you play whether it be senior or regular(exception to this was the June 25th Seniors, it wasn't available at the June 28th regular tournament).. On each envelope is marked what is in envelope and for what tournament. So read it before complaining to Jim or myself or any one else at the starting table. We keep very good track of the monies, so if it isn't there we usually find it in a short time.

Away tournaments and special tournament monies are handled separate of regular and senior monies. The monies will be given out by either Lou Soto or Jim Gonzales.

NO REGULAR TOURNAMENT IN JULY

Do to the Long beach Open there isn't a regular tournament is July, we had 2 in June.

SENIOR CORNER

We still have to pick up the pace of play, there are a couple groups that either do not want to or can't stay up with the group ahead. We had 7 teams that were from 12 to 15 minutes behind the group in front. That added up to a 1/2 hour of time lost. The first group finished in 4 hours and 40 minutes and my group (next to last) finished in 5 hours and 10 minutes. Of the 7 teams that were slow 4 were foursomes. So, playing fivesomes are not the reason for slow play. Please try and do your best to speed up.

As I stated on the front page our Club Championship are coming up and you have had to play in at least 4 club tournaments starting with the November, 2008 tournament. So keep this in mind if you haven't played in 4.

Our July 23rd Seniors will be a 42 -33-55 tournament. You will use 2 best balls for all par 4's, 3 best balls for par 3's and all scores on par 5's.

Our August tournament is a Nassau, followed by the Sept. Invitational. Remember your guest for the Invitational can be a male or female, and they do not have to be a senior.

Remember club championships are coming up and you have had to play in at least 4 club tournaments since the 2008 Turkey Shoot. Both regular & senior tournaments count.

for each player is \$37. All the usual individual side pots will be available.

On Saturday, September 5th we will hold the Annual Maurice Carl Invitational. This is a one-day Four-Ball (Partner's Best Ball) Stroke Play event, with both a Member-Guest and a Member-Member Flight. You may partner with another club member or bring a guest from another club, male or female. If you bring a guest from outside the club, the tournament committee needs to know your guest's correctly spelled name and handicap ID number (six or seven digit number). If your guest does not have a current established handicap index, we will use the Callaway one-day handicap system to determine your guests handicap for the event. If your guest does have a current established index, but you fail to provide it to the tournament committee on the entry form, your guest will play using the Callaway system. The tournament committee will not remind you, and will not be looking up handicap index numbers on the day of the tournament. It's your responsibility to provide the tournament committee with your guests handicap ID number. If you need a partner for this tournament, the tournament committee will do it's best to find one for you. Entry fee for this tournament is \$49 per player, \$98 per team.

On Saturday, October 3rd we will hold an Individual Stroke Play NASSAU tournament. This will also be the first round of the 2009 Club Championship. Entry fee for the October 3rd Nassau is \$37. If you are playing in the Club Championship (next three rounds are October 4, 10 and 11), there is an additional entry fee of \$119, for a total of \$156. The deadline for entry for the 2009 Club Championship is Thursday, September 24th. The tournament committee must have your paid entry by that date - NO EXCEPTIONS.

I also want to make another announcement in advance of the Club Championship. There will be no refunds of any kind given to any entrant in the Club Championship for any reason once the first round has begun on October 3rd. Every year, somewhere in the middle rounds of the four-round tournament, we seem to have a few people who come up with mysterious physical ailments or personal problems. These players also coincidentally are always playing badly. NO REFUNDS of any entry fees after the Championship has begun.

It appears we actually got through a tournament with all the Auxiliary placards filled out correctly. Everybody who signed was in the Auxiliary Pot, nobody signed in the wrong flight, and we could actually read all the entries. Thanks guys.

The tournament committee is looking forward to a great summer and fall tournament schedule. Remember, our club is very active and if you have a request, you need to get your entry in at least three weeks to a month before the tournament. The tournament committee does it's best to accommodate all requests. However, not everyone can play between 7:30 and 9 am. And finally, thanks again to all the unselfish club members who volunteer their valuable time to make all our tournaments a success by working the starting table and the scoring area. A very special thanks goes to the following. Doug Stodgel and Hal Peabody, who play early and then ensure that the starting table is closed properly and all documents and money are accounted for. Bobby Cervantes, Art and Tony Riesgo, Rich Stoffer and Dave Williams are responsible for the set-up and the tear down of all the tournament equipment. Sam Rizzardo, Bruce Gattton and Frank Gonzales are the first ones at the tournament with Bobby Cervantes' crew to set-up the starting table and work the first couple of hours with me at the check-in table. They play in the golf tournament and then stay to help with the scoring and the closing of the tournament. Doug Stodgel stays all day and does a superb, professional job on the scoreboard. Earl Gillings also comes in to help with the scoring whenever he can, although his schedule doesn't permit him to play in many tournaments. It's a long day for everyone. These are people who care about the club and the tournaments. It would be impossible to run these events without their valuable help. I know all the members appreciate their help. A thank you goes a long way for all these members.

GOLF COMMISSIONER'S REPORT—HAL PEABODY

The Golf Commission meeting for June was short with very few issues to discuss. The revenue generated by the Golf Courses for the city of Long Beach is actually holding pretty steady. The total rounds for April were down only seven tenths of one per cent and there was an increase in May of 3.3%. If you have played El Dorado recently, you might have noticed the changes to the bunkers by the fourth, ninth and seventeenth greens. All have been reduced in size to save maintenance costs without really changing the character of the holes. Construction has begun at Little Rec to improve the playability of the course and it should be complete by the end of July. The next big capital project is fixing the restrooms at Heartwell. Hopefully, the restrooms at our own Rec Park will be the next big project. The Skylinks short game practice area to the right of the driving range and behind the eighteenth green is now open and has received good reviews. The Mayor's Trophy tournament is coming up on July 13th. Dennis Walters, a paraplegic golfer, will be doing an exhibition that day at Skylinks and will then move over to Heartwell at 2 PM and do another exhibition for junior golfers and Special Olympics athletes. After seemingly working on all of the other courses, I am soliciting ideas for improvements to the golf course at Rec Park. If you have any ideas for course improvements that you think should be implemented, please pass them to me at the Men's Club meeting or email me at hpea-body@webbox.com and I will bring them up at our next Golf Commission meeting in August.
