CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

You can count both Regular & Senior tournaments. So if you haven't met this requirement you still have 2 regular and 4 senior tournament left before the start of club championships.

GREEN FEE INCREASE

The tournament entry fees will be increased \$1 to \$37 per tournament for our regular tournaments, effective 6-20-09. That's the latest word we have on any fee increases from American Golf or the City of Long Beach. For all those who paid too much for previous tournaments, the list of credits will be available by the third week of June. Remember, you cannot mix credits between the Regular and Senior tournaments. If you take a credit, be sure to note that fact on your entry form. It's already an accounting nightmare, and I don't want to make it worse than it is already. Have a little patience, it's only a few dollars, and we'll get it straightened out over the next few months.

The next regular tournament will be held on Sunday, June 28th. It will be an individual Stroke Play event. There are already a large number of sign-ups. It will also serve as the second round for those who signed up for the June Eclectic Combo tournament. Remember, there will be NO regular tournament in the month of July, due to the Long Beach Golf Festival events.

We will get back to tournament action on Saturday, August 8th with the 24-33-45 Foursome Event. Bob Caseres, TJ Hyman, Ron Johns and Dom Juneau should be back to defend their title that they won with a 157 team score. Here's how it works for those who didn't participate last year. The team will take the two (2) low net balls on all the four-pars, the three (3) low net balls on all the three-pars, and all four (4) net balls on the five-pars. Par for the event is 168. You can sign-up as a foursome - or a single, or anything in between. Entry fee for each player is \$37. All the usual individual side pots will be available.

Now, some housekeeping. Almost every month, we mention two subjects and every month we get questions about these policies or people that pretend that they have never heard of them. First, CANCELLATION POLICY. Club policy states that if you cancel out of a golf tournament with less than eight days notice you will forfeit your entry fee. This policy has been in effect for many years, and has been stated over and over again. Putting on golf tournaments of our size requires a monetary commitment to the management of the golf course and the City of Long Beach. We must commit to the tee

TIMING ON 18

For the last 3 months we have timed players on the 18th hole and the way it works is we have the group ahead (onel player) wait until the group behind finishes and marks down the time from the clock at the 18th hole. We have had several groups ignore this rule, in the future if you do not wait your group will be DQ'd from the tournament.

SCRIPT & SIDEPOT MONEY

Script & sidepot money is given to you at the tournament. Both regular and senior monies are handed out. If you play in both senior & regular you will receive your script in the next tournament you play whether it be senior or regular. On each envelope is marked what is in envelope and for what tournament. So read it before complaining to Jim or myself or any one else at the starting table. We keep very good track of the monies, so if it isn't there we usually find it in a short time.

Away tournaments and special tourna-

Ment monies are handled separate of regular and senior monies. The monies will given out by either Lou Soto or Jim Gonzales.

NO REGULAR TOURNAMENT IN JULY

Do to the Long Beach Open there is no regular tournament in July, we are playing 2 tournament in June.

times eight days before the tournament. We must pay for the tee times eight days before the tournament. We must pay for the tee times that we have committed to American Golf, whether we use them or not. There are no exceptions to this policy, just as there are no exceptions to our commitments. Yet, every month we have to deal with a few members ;that know and understand the policy, but simply want to try an excuse to get their money back. There are no exceptions of any kind to the policy. If you cancel with less than eight days notice, you forfeit your entry fee.

Also, along the same lines. If you enter a tournament just prior to the tournament by phone call or e-mail, you are responsible for the entry fees. If you don't show up for the tournament, you are still responsible for the entry fees. If you don't pay these fees, you will not be allowed to play in another tournament, until the past due fees are paid. You also will not be allowed to enter another tournament without paying the fees in advance. Once burned is enough here.

Second subject. The Closest to the pin placards (Holes 5, 12, 15 and 16) are becoming a problem. I don't understand the reason, it seems to me that it is a simple matter. On Hole #5, there is ONE winner - no flights. The closest to the pin on hole #5 is part of your entry fee. Everyone in the tournament is eligible for closest to the pin on this hole. If you see a distance that is closer than the distance your tee shot landed on Hole #5, DO NOT write your name down, it just confuses the issue.

On Holes #12, 15 and 16 you must be in the AUXILIARY POT to be eligible for the closest to the pin pots. These pots are broken down into two flights; A flight (0-12) and B flight (13+). Almost every month someone makes an incorrect entry and costs some other player a payoff. DO NOT PLACE YOUR NAME ON THE PLACARDS for holes 12, 15, or 16 IF YOU HAVE NOT ENTERED THE AUXILIARY POTS. DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME IN "A" FLIGHT IF YOU ARE A 13 HANDICAP OR HIGHER. THERE IS ONLY ONE PLACE PAID PER FLIGHT PER HOLE. IF YOU SEE A DISTANCE THAT IS CLOSER THAN YOU ARE, DO NOT WRITE YOUR NAME AND DISTANCE ON THE PLACARD.

By the way, all the above is stated on the placards in RED letters. Players aren't paying attention, and are costing other players their rightful pot winnings. I am going to recommend to the membership at the next general meeting, that if anyone makes an error on the placards for closet to the pin, they will be fined the size of the pot on that particular hole. We already have a \$25 penalty, but that's not doing the job. Hopefully, you will support my recommendation at the next general meeting. And for those of you making the mistakes, get with the program.times that we have committed to American Golf, whether we use them or not. There are no exceptions to this policy, just as there are no exceptions to our commitments. Last subject - PACE OF PLAY. Read the following, you know what your tee time was in the June 7th tournament, and you will see how the elapsed time for a round in our tournaments disintegrates. If your group is one of the culprits, somebody PLEASE take charge and get your group moving. All groups should finish within 7-9 minutes of the group in front of them. We lost only 8 minutes off the first tee. We shouldn't lose any, as the 7-8 minute interval to tee off is more than adequate. But from the first group to the last group in elapsed time, we lost 1 hour and 40 minutes. Guys, that's totally unacceptable. We don't expect you to play in 3 hours and 35 minutes, but we do expect you to play in 4 hours 20 minutes to 4 hours and 30 minutes. If you give a damn about our privledges at Recreation Park GC, you must help me to get these elapsed times down significantly. The facts don't lie. If we lose just 2 minutes per group over the entire field, that adds up to 1 hour and 30 minutes longer to play. Your elapsed time should be pretty close to the group in front of you. Please take a look at the chart below and if everyone will just save a few minutes in their group per round, we can all play in 4 hours and 20 or 30 minutes. That would be acceptable. I need everyone's help on this continuing problem.

GOLF COMMISSIONER'S REPORT—HAL PEABODY

The May meeting of the Long Beach Municipal Golf Commission was held a week early and the Commission members did not receive their normal financial and golf status reports as they were not complete yet. Over all the Long Beach golf courses are down in rounds by only about 1/10 of one per cent. Revenue is down for the city by a similar number 3/10 of one per cent for the same period last year. The remodel of Little Rec will begin shortly and is expected to be complete by then of July. There were lots of extra guests at this month's meeting to discuss proposed changes to the Shotgun Tournament Policy for the "grandfathered" tournaments. After Mr. Gooch and other prominent representatives of these charity tournaments spoke, the Golf Commission recommended that the status quo for these events remain with not further changes. The E-Range policies are still muddled, perhaps intentionally. It seems each course has a different answer as to when to turn in your old range cards for the new keys. I was told by the starter at Rec Park that the machine to read the old cards in the pro shop will be there on June 1st to begin the conversion; we'll see. The Mayor's Trophy Tournament will be at Skylinks on Monday July 13th. This year the proceeds will benefit Long Beach Junior Golf and Special Olympics.
