TOURNAMENT NEWS JIM GONZALES

This column is being written prior to the Sunday, November 1st Turkey Shoot. I will be out of town at a charity tournament in Texas, but Gordon Olson and the tournament committee will handle the event. Hopefully, the good weather will continue both in Long Beach and San Antonio.

With the recent increase in fees, the committee will have to collect a lot of small additional fees from the players. The Turkey Shoot is now \$51 and since we allow entries to be sent in months in advance, a lot of the entries are a few dollars short per player. This collection of additional fees will continue through the Chicken and Bean in December and the Membership Tournament in January as we already have received entries for those two events. Your cooperation in collecting the additional fees is appreciated. It's always a pain when fees get raised without much notice and believe me, it's a book-keeping and collection nightmare for myself and the committee.

The last regular tournament of the year, our annual Chicken and Bean, will be held on Sunday, December 6th. With the most recent fee increase, the fee for the tournament is now \$73.00, which includes cart fees. For those of you who want to walk, YOU must find another player to walk with you in your group and you need to state that on your entry along with whom will be your walking partner. You can only walk in pairs. Otherwise, you must pay the cart fee. The tournament committee will not try to find a walking partner for you; that is strictly up to you if you prefer to walk.

This is our most fun event of the year. If you have never participated, this event goes on all day starting with a 7:30 shotgun tournament. We play in SIXSOMES. After the initial eighteen holes, we will have the DERBY (optional side event), which is a partner's alternate shot knock-out event. Entry for the derby is \$ 40 per two-man team. You absolutely do not want to miss the dinner that follows later in the afternoon and the presentations and prizes for all those who remain for dinner.

All our regular pot games will be available for the Chicken and Bean tournament. Remember, the check-in table closes and the deadline for pot game sign-ups is 7 am. Also, the best tee prizes go to those who check-in

GOLF COMMISSION REPORT—HAL PEABODY

The October Golf Commission was mostly about the post mortems on the fee increases that were implemented on October 19th. Public golfers have really become a disenfranchised minority. We make up less than 2% of the population, but Public Golfers seemed to be the first ones to have to pony up the extra bucks when times are tough and Governments aren't creative enough to find other revenue streams. The Golf Commission expressed their desire to have the proposed increase at Rec Park be phased in over two years, but the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine went ahead with their plan to bring El Dorado and Rec Park in alignment in October 2011. Also, the city decided to implement the increased rate at all courses for Fridays above the Golf Commission's objections. Now the Rec Park Weekday Resident rate goes to \$26, the Friday Resident rate is \$28 and the Weekend Resident rate is \$32. Please be aware that the \$1 surcharge is still in effect for all rates as implemented last spring for all courses. The Rec Park Standard (Non-resident) rate is now \$33 for Weekdays, \$35 for Fridays and \$44 for Weekends. The movement of equalizing the price at Rec Park and El Dorado was explained by the city as Rec Park is as good of a course as El Dorado. The Department of Parks, Recreation, and Marine has yet to provide a satisfactory explanation as to why, when the El Dorado was upgraded, that the lessee, American Golf, has never been required to keep the maintenance at El Dorado in "tournament" condition at all times. This was the motivation for raising greens fees at El Dorado above Rec Park in the first place. The first mention of moving back towards equal greens fees at the three full size courses was brought up by the Long Beach Superintendent of Golf at this month's meeting. Of course, there will be plenty of financial analysis done to justify this. Expect sometime in 2011 for the Skylinks greens fees to be lowered very slightly and Rec Park and El Dorado's prices raised again to meet that new price point; whatever it is. For this past fiscal year, the revenues provided to the city by American Golf were \$4.5 million. This is down about \$217,000 from the prior year. This is a decrease of about 4.8% and is generally less than most courses in the U.S. Golf rounds are down by only 1% in Long Beach for the year. This is excellent considering the golf business has taken about a 10% hit throughout most of the United States. The city is looking at the final bids for the clean up of the restrooms at Rec Park, including new paint and carpet. The money is coming out of the Capital Improvement Plan fund. The Golf Department for the city is also planning a Long Beach Golf Specific website in the near future. It is planned to have a complete listing of all Long Beach Hall of Fame inductees with biographies. Also, the monthly calendar will be posted so that golfers can check to see which course have upcoming tournaments to avoid. Well, I have run out of space for this month, so have a Happy Thanksgiving!
