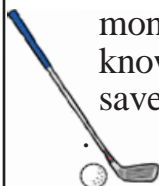

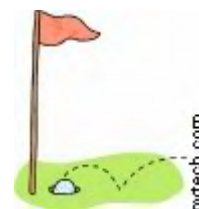

### News from the Golf Commission April 2009

As recommended by the Golf Commission, the Parks Department will assign a temporary "surcharge" at the various courses in the city. the fees will be as follows:

1. \$1 for all 18-hole rounds at regulation courses.
2. 50 cents for resident seniors, all juniors, all twilight and "special rates" at the regulation courses.
3. At Heartwell and South Course, 50 cents on all rounds except resident seniors, all juniors all twilight and all special rounds.

The surcharge will be temporary with a request made that it expire at the end of the next fiscal year, September 30, 2010.

There seems to be some misunderstanding on the proper procedure for securing tee times for our weekend play. When a tournament is scheduled, tee times are assigned by the tournament chairman. When there is no tournament, tee times are assigned on a first come, first served basis. For the first three (3) tee times, the player must be physically present at the starter's counter to sign up. Payment of green fees is to be made at this time. For the rest of the tee times, a member, who is physically present at the starter's counter, may sign up others who are not yet present at the course. Payment for these times must be made when signing up. No tee times may be reserved via the telephone or the internet for our regular weekend tee times.

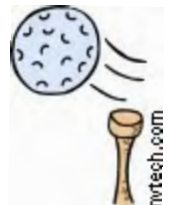
An important vote will be taken at the May meeting concerning qualifying for golfer of the month. Everyone's input is welcome.

Handicap chairman, Stan Olin, is requesting that when posting nine hole scores we use the "white tee" selection.



- If the player deems his ball to be unplayable, he must, under penalty of one stroke:
- Play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played; or
  - Drop a ball behind the point where the ball lay, keeping that point directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is dropped, or
  - Drop a ball within two club-lengths of the spot where the ball lay, but not nearer the hole.

Penalty for breach of rule: Stroke play- 2 strokes; Match play- loss of hole.
