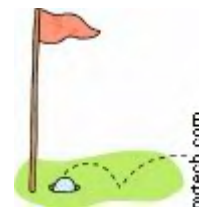

Please remember to pay for electric golf carts. See Recpark.com newsletter for an article about the golf cart problem across the street.

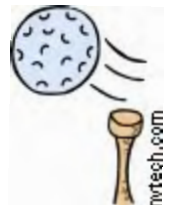

Handicap chairman, Stan Olin, is requesting that when posting nine hole scores we use the “white tee” selection



If you address the ball and ground your club and the ball moves, you must replace the ball and take a 1 stroke penalty. If you do not replace the ball, it is a 2 stroke penalty.

You must identify your ball in a hazard now before hitting it or you may be hitting the wrong ball with a 2 stroke penalty.
