## Golfer of the Month

To qualify for golfer of the month, a player must submit a scorecard that is signed and dated by the player. The score must be attested by a fellow member as to its accuracy. The card needs to indicate “ golfer of the month ” and be placed in the box next to the computer in the pro shop.

Golfer of the Month for July---Dale Hoppe -- net 52

Golfer of the month for August--Art Reyes-- net 57

Golfer of the month qualifies for the golfer of the year tournament at the Ham & Bean tournament in December

When submitting a scorecard for consideration for Golfer of the Month, include your full (first and last) name ( we have many mikes, joes, arts,bills,bobs), the date of the round, must be attested to by another member, must be legible, use arabic numbers( 1,2,3 etc.) for the score on each hole, must state “ golfer of the month ” on card.  
It is not the chairman’s job to try to decipher submitted scorecards.

## Club and Community news

Construction for the bioswale near the seventh fairway has been started. When we play # 7 as a par four, the area inside the temporary construction fence will be considered “ ground under repair” from which play is prohibited. The player must drop a ball, without penalty, within one club length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief( rule 25-1).

It is time for renewals again. All renewals must be in to Nils by November 30, 2009. There is no grace period. The renewal fee is the same as last year \$55, payable to South Course Men’s Club. There is a renewal form in this edition of the newsletter.
