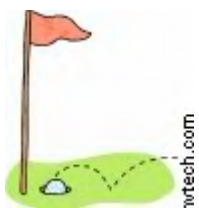

The local rules at rec park south were designed to speed up play and to give the player options on how to play his shot. Please incorporate them into your game.

Local rules at Rec Park South



1. Immovable obstructions

Protective fences, man-made objects, staked trees.

Nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, for stance, swing and line of sight to the hole.

Note: Boundary fences and their concrete bases are not considered immovable obstructions and no relief is offered without penalty.

2. Colorado Lagoon at #7 to be considered a Lateral Water Hazard.

If you hit one in the water, you may:

1. Hit a provisional.

2. Re-tee hitting 3.

3. Keep the spot where it went in the water between you and the hole and drop. Hitting 3.

4. Drop at the Ladies/gray marker. Considered a drop area. Hitting 3.

If you choose this option, original ball is abandoned.

3. Dirt extension of cart paths to be considered part of the cart path.

4. Keep up with the group in front of you.



Results of Ham and Bean/ Golfer of the Year

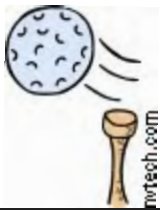
