Thanks to Bob Coffman and Bob Nelson for their work in keeping our local tournaments on schedule, and Dennis for our big course away tournaments.

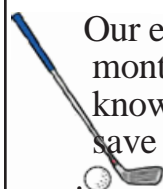

## Local rules for Rec Park South



### 1. Immovable obstructions.

Protective fences, man made objects, staked trees.  
Nearest point of relief , no nearer the hole, for swing,  
stance, and line of sight. No penalty.

Note: Boundary fences and their concrete bases are not  
considered immovable obstructions and no relief is offered  
without penalty.

### 2. Hole #7 to be considered a lateral water hazard.

On #7 if you hit one in the water you may:

1. Hit a provisional
2. Re tee hitting three
3. Keeping the spot where it went in the water between  
you and the hole, drop hitting three
4. Drop at the Gray marker ( Forward tee) hitting three.  
If you choose this option, ball is abandoned.

### 3. Dirt extensions of cart paths to be considered part of the cart path.

### 4. Keep up with the group in front of you.
