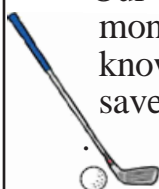

Golfer of the month qualifies for the golfer of the year tournament at the Ham & Bean tournament in December

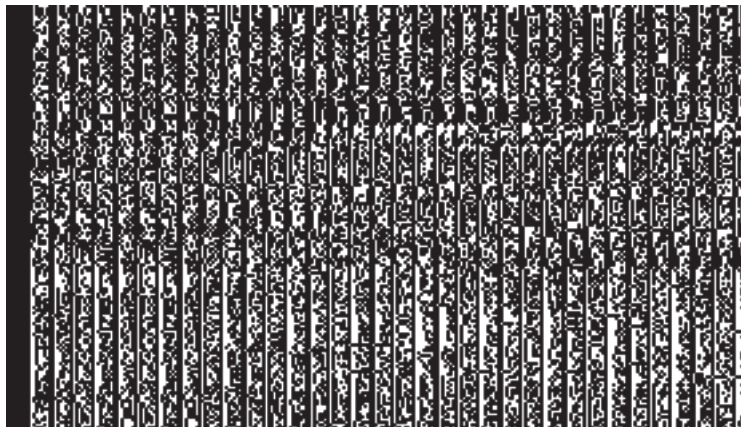


Club and Community news

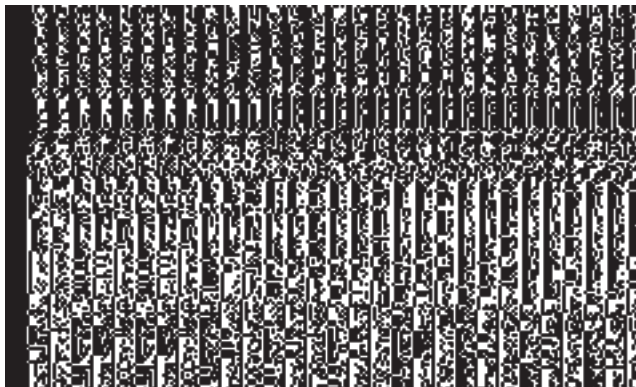
