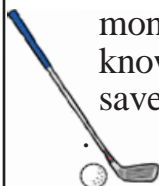

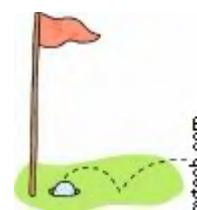

Handicap chairman, Stan Olin, is requesting that when posting nine hole scores we use the "white tee" selection.



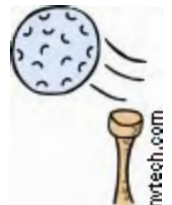
Golfer of the Month
